First of all, we are heading to Baekhwasan. Baekhwasan Cloud Bridge is a bridge that allows you to enjoy the beautiful mountain and sea between two peaks at 250m above sea level. In particular, Taean-gun explains that it is built in a location where you can see both the open Garolim Bay and the foot of Mt. On the way to the cloud bridge, you may see the Taeeulam Hermitage, well-known for Rock-carved Standing Buddha Triad



The mud flat in western sea of South Korea is one of the 5 largest mud flats in the world. The gap

between in/out of tide is huge, which makes Taean's mud flat much more fertile than others. Especially after the tide's out, hidden black mud flat comes out, which is the most beautiful part of Taean. You can find various marine creatures in the wetlands while the tide is out.
